Welcome back to another fun-filled educational term.

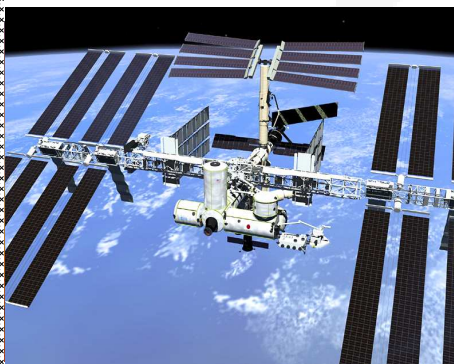
