### Literacy

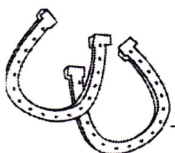

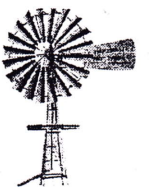
### School Grounds

**RECIPE CORNER**

**So Easy Orange Cake**

- 1 orange, skin on, pith and seeds removed
- 210g butter, melted and cooled
- 1 cup caster sugar
- 2 eggs
- ¼ cup desiccated coconut
- A few drops of lemon essence
- 1 ½ cups self-raising flour, sifted
- Orange icing to serve

Preheat oven to moderate. Lightly grease and line 20cm round cake pan.  
In a food processor combine orange, butter, sugar, eggs, coconut and essence.  
Process until orange is finely chopped.  
Pour orange mixture into a large bowl. Fold in flour to just combine. Pour batter into pan.  
Bake 30-35 minutes, until golden and cooked when tested.  
Ice with orange icing when completely cool.

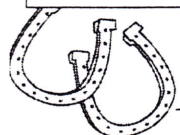
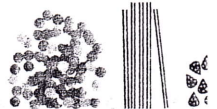

*'Zone of Origin'*

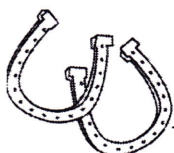

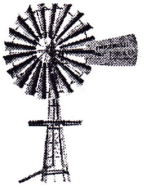
