For some people Christmas time is attending their local church for the Yuletide service. However you choose to celebrate Christmas may it be a happy and enjoyable one. Cheers!!!

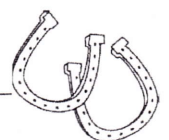

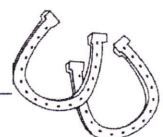

Cook It, Move It Do It! And we are moving...

Cook It, Move It, Do It; three simple, little actions that are part of our every day lives, but there is more meaning behind it for certain residents within the Rockhampton Region.

Between 60 to 70 residents have taken the first step to making a positive change in their life by signing it up to KickstartCQ's Cook It, Move It, Do It Program.

This program is part of a national initiative designed to engage and motivate residents who may need assistance in making a positive change in their own life.

Chair of Rockhampton Regional Council's Parks and Recreation Committee, Councillor Cherie Rutherford congratulates those who have taken the first step.

"It can be difficult for many to take that first step to making a positive change in their lives, and I congratulate the 70 residents within our community who have made the concise decision to be more healthy and active" said Cr Rutherford.

"It would be great to see everyone within our community getting up, moving and being active and this is something that Rockhampton Regional Council and KickstartCQ are working towards".

The Cook It, Move It, Do It programs offers a range of different services and programs to suit different needs. These include cooking classes, outdoor gym sessions, walking groups, subsidised programs such as Lift for Life, and support through out the process.

Through the Cook It, Move It, Do It program, 13 pieces of exercise equipment have been purchased for distribution throughout the Region. These new items are additional to current installations in Frenchville Road, Elphinstone Street, and Currawong Street in Rockhampton and Cowan Street at Gracemere.

New equipment will be placed at Huish Drive; Rockhampton, Mount Morgan Number 7 Dam, and Main Beach; Yeppoon, enabling access for residents across our whole Region.

Outdoor gym sessions are currently held at Rigirlsford Park on a Tuesday morning from 9am till 10am. Everyone is encouraged to go, learn how to use the equipment, and talk to our Healthy Communities Coordinator. Once equipment is fully installed, outdoor gym sessions will be held at these new locations.

The Healthy Communities Coordinator will also be at Centrelink, Musgrave Street Rockhampton every Thursday till 12pm to provide residents with information on how they can get involved in the Cook It, Move It, Do It Program.

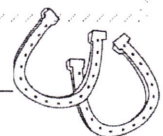

December 9, 1941 - During World War II, China issued a formal declaration of war against Japan, Germany and Italy.

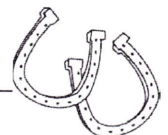
December 15, 1964 - Canada adopted a new national flag featuring a red maple leaf on a white background.

PROUD TO BE A PART OF A GREAT COMMUNITY!

On Friday the 26th of October the rollover of a B Double belonging to Les Stokes Livestock Transport happened on the corner near Ridglands & Calmorin Road turn off, Ridglands. Thankfully the driver was not seriously hurt, but sadly many of the cattle on board were killed or had to be destroyed. During the many hours involved in the massive clean-up we saw what belonging to a community is all about.

Within a short period of time and a few phone calls, many of our community members were on the scene. These people were so valuable to the clean-up effort words could not describe it. We had many who bought their horses, machinery, food and drinks and most of all their skills. The operators on the machines done a brilliant job of breaking open the crates that the cattle were trapped in so they could be released and the area cleaned-up. Food and drinks were bought from town and delivered to the accident site for all the workers. This was greatly appreciated, as many had no time to bring their own. They were only thinking of how fast they could get there to assist. The people on horses and the ones on the ground used their knowledge in assisting upon the release from the upturned crates of animals that were still alive, and as one person described it "It was magic watching them, the way they handled the distressed animals and how they worked together to make it as stress free as they possibly could for the animals involved" Then as a team, they held the cattle together as a mob on the side of the road until all that survived were released and later walked them to the local show/camp draft grounds. Once again we also had community members checking on them and addressing their water and hay supplies. The hours involved in this were long, the machinery operators were still working late into the night and a cold beer was enjoyed by all when the job was complete. A thank you has to go out to all the traffic on the road at the time, as the road was closed for several hours and everyone had a great attitude.

As many of you would know Les Stokes personally, we would like to pass on our sincere best wishes for a good outcome from the accident. Les is a great bloke and runs a very professional business. Les supports our annual camp draft and spends many big days transporting cattle for this event. We are looking forward to once again being one of your customers when you are up and running again.

When you hear people say that there is no community spirit these days, I have just got to disagree. If you could have seen ours in action, it was enough to make your heart swell with pride. So a big congratulations to all those involved. I would love to name you all, but there were so many and I would not like to miss anyone. These are people you know you can rely on and trust and if you ever need a hand, they will be there. You make us so proud and I wouldn't live anywhere else for quids!

SIMPLE CHRISTMAS PUDDING

125g butter
1 cup brown sugar
2 eggs
1 ¼ cups plain flour
1 cup breadcrumbs
410g jar fruit mince
2 tablespoons brandy
1 teaspoon mixed spice



Step 1

Grease a 4-cup pudding basin with butter. Cut a circle of baking paper to fit into base.

Step 2

Beat butter and sugar until light and creamy. Add eggs, beating well after each.

Stir in flour, breadcrumbs, fruit mince, brandy and mixed spice. Stir well and transfer to pudding basin.

Step 3

Lay a piece of foil onto a bench top. Top with a sheet of baking paper.

Make a pleat along the centre to allow pudding to rise.

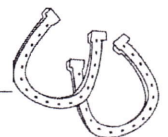
Cover pudding and tie with string. Sit on a trivet in a large pot.

Pour boiling water down the side of the pot.

Bring to the boil, reduce heat and simmer for two hours.

Serve with cream or custard and raspberries (optional).

Dust with icing sugar.
