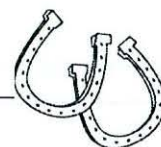

## Rockhampton Regional Council news

As the South Rockhampton Flood Levee Proposal moves forward, Acting Mayor Tony Williams is assuring the community there are still a number of important steps to take before the levee is built, including detailed engineering design and extensive community consultation.

"We want to ensure that everyone gets the opportunity to have their say, and to have access to all the relevant information as it becomes available," Cr Williams said.

"Today we have launched our community feedback register, which gives the community the chance to have their say or ask questions regarding the levee."

"This register is available on our website, or by contacting our Customer Service Centres in person or by calling 1300 22 55 77."

Cr Williams said the register was the start of an extensive engagement plan that would be ramped-up once funding from the State and Federal Governments was confirmed.

### Statement from Cr Fisher:

I'd like to clarify some apparent confusion regarding a Rockhampton Regional Council media release about the Region's Roadside Bin Stations, issued on 30 April 2013. The statement was released for the entire Rockhampton Region commenting on waste stations from all corners of the Region.

While some of our roadside bin stations operate well, there are some others that often misused, and the release was to serve as a reminder to all residents of how they should be using any bin station within the Region.

This media release was sent to all local media – print, radio, TV and online.

We do have issues with some bin and recycle stations but others have been highly successful.

We have 11 unmanned bin and recycle stations across the entire Region and we are constantly evaluating how all of them are used.

All rate payers actually pay for the waste services whether they are rural or urban residents.

Urban residents pay extra for kerbside bin services as well as the landfill and other waste provision fees.

A recent inspection at the Laurel Bank Bin Station in particular showed that people using the facility irresponsibly hailed from several locations within the region and were not isolated to one suburb. This is true of several of our bin stations, which is why we sought to address the problem with a media release directed at anyone using any bin station within the Region. Nerimbera's station for example is a station that is running well, and is a model for the rest of the Region.

Nerimbera is the same distance from urban Rockhampton as Laurel Bank, and we are looking at the differences between the two to see how improvements can be made.

We are about to embark on consultation and we want to hear your suggestions on how we can better manage our stations and solve some of the current issues. At Laurel Bank, Council has increased its clean up, with the station now being serviced daily. This comes at a significant cost to the entire Rockhampton Regional community, so is not a long term solution, but will give some reprieve while we work towards a solution.

We are currently working towards a solution that has to suit the entire Rockhampton Region, and look forward to working closely with communities around the Rockhampton Region as we work towards this.

Our consultation on improving our waste services is currently underway and I encourage you all to come to our meeting at Alton Downs Hall from 7pm to 8.30pm on Monday 26 August.

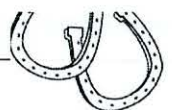
### CRUNCHY SALMON BAKE

#### Ingredients:

8 slices wholemeal bread, crusts removed  
2 tablespoons olive oil  
210g can red salmon, drained and flaked  
1 ½ tablespoons chopped chives  
1 tablespoon finely chopped parsley  
150g ricotta cheese  
2 eggs lightly beaten  
2 tablespoons grated parmesan  
Freshly ground pepper

#### Method:

Lightly flatten each slice of bread with a rolling pin.  
Brush bread lightly with the olive oil.  
Mix together salmon, chives, parsley and pepper.  
Spread evenly on to the bread.  
Roll up each slice and place in a single layer in a slightly greased casserole dish.  
Beat together the ricotta and eggs, pour over the bread rolls and sprinkle with parmesan.  
Bake in a preheated 180 degrees oven for about 30 minutes or until topping is set and golden.

### Licence Reforms for Older Drivers

Currently, drivers aged 75 and over must carry a medical certificate at all times, which may be issued for a few months or for up to five years, however from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2014, when you need a new medical certificate, it will only be valid for a maximum of 12 months. If, on the 1<sup>st</sup> January, you have a medical certificate which doesn't expire for some years, you will still be able to use this. When it expires, your new certificate will then be valid for up to 12 months. For further information, phone Queensland Transport on 13 23 80.
